

Internal Displacement in Ukraine

Overview of Situation in November 2018

GENERAL OVERVIEW

As of November 26, 2018, [1,519,654 IDPs](#) from Donetsk, Luhansk regions and Crimea were registered.

On November 26, 2018, the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine approved [Presidential Decree about the imposition of martial law](#) in 10 out of 24 regions of Ukraine for a period of 30 days. According to the [Constitution of Ukraine](#), allows the possibility of restriction of number of constitutional rights in the conditions of martial law, in particular such as: the integrity of housing, the secret of correspondence and telephone conversations, privacy, freedom of movement, choice of place of residence, freedom of expression, etc.

Ministry of Social Policy made an infographic on "Provision of housing for IDPs, who defended the independence, sovereignty and territorial integrity of Ukraine." Infographic illustrates that IDPs with a status of combatants and IDPs with disabilities (Group III) caused by an armed action, have right to receive financial compensation for the purchase of housing. It also contains information on what is needed to make financial compensation, how to register in public housing waiting list, what is possible to purchase for the funds allocated, how to get financial compensation and what counting formula is used for compensation. In November 2018, the hotline of the NGO "CrimeaSOS" received the largest 125 applications. The most critical problems remain concerning the registration, renewal, correction and receiving of documents (passport, birth/death certificate, pension certificate, diploma certificate, etc.). Furthermore, increased the number of addresses about real estate (purchase, sale, inheritance).
