4 times increase of an area illegally annexed by Russia, equivalent to an area of Bulgaria

About **100,000** Ukrainian citizens have left Crimea, including about **50,000** Crimean Tatars

Up to **800,000** Russian citizens have illegally arrived in Crimea, equivalent to a third of the local population before 2014

Only 0.2% of Crimean schoolchildren now studying in the Ukrainian language, compared to 7.2% before 2014

More than **12,500** Crimean prisoners transferred to penal facilities located on Russian territory, with some being held **9,000** km away from home, which is longer than the distance from Kyiv to New York

At least 218 individuals now illegally imprisoned in Crimea, including 132 Crimean Tatars

About **50,000** Crimeans unlawfully conscripted into the Russian army

At least **520** criminal cases instituted over draft evasion

More than **40** seriously ill Ukrainian citizens now illegally imprisoned in Crimea

In Crimea there are at least 104 cases of enforced disappearances, with the fate and whereabouts of 21 still unknown

More than **818** administrative fines for allegedly discrediting the Russian army for a total amount of more than USD 250,000

At least **13 lawyers** have suffered from oppressions

At least **464 arbitrary** searches, including **329** in the houses of Crimean Tatars

At least **21 journalists** have suffered from criminal persecution, with 17 still imprisoned

More than **90%** drop in the number of media outlets

Nearly **2.5 times**decrease in a number of religious
organizations – from 2200 to 932

At least **93 facts of persecution of Muslims**, Jehovah's Witnesses, the Orthodox Church of Ukraine, Protestants and other religious groups
